### **\*Family Blessings (Genesis 25:19-34, 27:1-46)**

- Isaac gave his sons blessings, Jacob and Esau were brothers, but they were very different.

### **\*Joseph and His Brothers (Genesis 37:1-36; 42:1-46)**

- Joseph forgave his brothers, and Joseph and his brothers were reconciled.

### **\*Moses and His Sister (Exodus 1:8-2:10)**

- Moses was adopted by Pharaoh's daughter

### **\*Sisters (Luke 1:38-42)**

- Mary and Martha had Jesus as a guest for dinner. The two sisters had different priorities in providing hospitality and spending time with Jesus.


**Sunday Mornings at 9:30am**
